OPEN NIGHT





CHANGES FOR TERM 2

90% OR ABOVE ATTENDANCE

From Term 2 students will need to have a 90% school attendance rate to be eligible to attend non-curriculum activities including excursions and incursions.

While not a new initiative, we will begin enforcing it next term. Earlier this term, we let our students know, and at that stage, almost all students had the opportunity to reach 90% attendance by attending the remaining weeks left in the term. On Thursday 1 April 2021, 89% of the school attended which is the highest last day of term attendance we were able to find on record! Congratulations to our students and parents who made this happen!

We want our students to value their education and being away from school has a negative impact on this. When your child misses school they miss important opportunities to learn, build friendships and develop life skills. The graphic below shows how missing school can really add up:



You can use the Parent Portal to track your child's attendance. We ask that, unless it is unavoidable, appointments for your child to see doctors, physios or other specialists, be made outside of school learning hours. If this is not possible, the school must be notified, your child needs to find out what work they will miss, and the absence will count towards your child's official record of attendance as absences.

Also, we know there are some extenuating circumstances that can cause extended absences from school. If this is the case, please keep us informed so we can ensure your child stays on top of their school work.

We want all of our students to be eligible to particulate in co-curricular activities, sports, and incursions however it takes all of us to help make this happen. Thank you for your support with this. Showing up is the key to success - one the core values we strive for at Narrabeen Sports High School.
