By signing this form:

1. I accept that I will be invoiced \$620.00 per semester (2 terms) for my child in Years 7 to 10 and \$360 per semester (2 terms) in Years 11& 12 for Membership in the Academy Developing or Emerging Athlete Program.
2. Membership for the Student Athlete Academic Support Program (SAASP) - 1. Manly United FC student-athletes: \$620 per semester (includes training in Manly United FC program) 2. Student-athletes currently training in Academy programs: \$360 per semester (this allows access to both the Academy training program AND the SAASP) 3. National and state level student-athletes not currently in Academy programs: No cost
3. I acknowledge that my child will not be accepted into the Sports Academy without payment being made per semester in **advance**. I also acknowledge and accept that this fee is a membership to the Academy and cannot be refunded.
4. I acknowledge that if my child is accepted into the Academy Program he/she may not change to another Academy sport until the following semester. This request to change sports must be made in writing at least two weeks prior to the end of the current semester.
5. I acknowledge that I may be charged for any travelling or excursion expenses.
6. If my child participates in Academy Swimming I will be charged an additional \$200.00 per semester to cover bus travel and pool entry. If my child participates in Academy Surfing or Baseball I will be charged an additional \$100.00 per semester to cover bus travel back to school.
7. I acknowledge that to be eligible for continuation in the Academy programs, students must demonstrate a continued commitment to school studies, maintain an exemplary record of school conduct and fulfil training requirements of the Academy. If a student fails to apply him/herself in their academic studies as indicated by unsatisfactory effort in more than one subject, then their place in the Academy may be reviewed.
8. I acknowledge that for serious breaches of the school discipline code or continued unacceptable behaviour, a student may be excluded from participation in the Academy and fees will not be refunded. **Please note: The Sport Organisers within the Sports Academy will informally counsel students who exhibit unacceptable behaviour. However, on the third written Academy disciplinary warning (these warnings will be linked to any disruptive behaviour at Academy sessions, or Level 3 school disciplinary warnings) the student's membership to the Academy will be rescinded for the remainder of the semester and fees for that semester will not be refunded. (The student may reapply for membership prior to the start of the following semester).**
9. I acknowledge that conditions of "out-of-area" entry to Narrabeen Sports High School include membership to the Sports Academy. In the event that a student withdraws or is withdrawn from the Academy he/she may be asked to leave the school.
10. I acknowledge that an "in-area" student can only withdraw from the Academy at the end of a school semester and that withdrawal of membership from the Academy must be in writing at least two weeks before the end of the semester.
11. Permission to travel to or from the school site by bus or on foot under the supervision of a staff member.
12. Permission for the school/department to publish information about my child in publicly accessible communications. This permission remains effective until I advise otherwise.
13. A \$220 deposit is required to secure membership in the Sports Academy following a successful trial. This deposit will be deducted from the Semester invoice.
14. Permission is given to trial for enrolment at Narrabeen Sports High School at various locations on and close to the school. Students will make their own way to and from the venue and will be dismissed at the completion of the trial.
15. Medical Insurance; Parents please note there is no personal injury insurance cover provided by the NSW Department of Education and Training for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. Parents and caregivers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school zone, area and state school sport association when deciding whether additional insurance cover, above that provided by Medicare, is required. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail insurance outlets. The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injuries Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, covers any injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or the use of some prescribed part of the body.
